## School Safety

Safety of students and staff is a primary concern of Del Paso Heights Elementary School. The school is always in compliance with all laws, rules and regulations pertaining to hazardous materials and state earthquake standards. To ensure school safety, all visitors are to report to the office. District employees and personnel wear ID badges, and staff is on duty before and after school.
